BIOL 276 Evolution of Vertebrate Life. Renumber to BIOL 474. Change prerequisites from BIOL 101 and 101L to BIOL 201 or 202. ***(fall 2013)***

BIOL 276L Vertebrate Structure and Evolution Laboratory. Renumber to BIOL 474L. Change the pre-or corequisite from BIOL 276 to BIOL 474. Change the description from "Recommended preparation, BIOL 252 or familiarity with anatomy. Vertebrate comparative anatomy of organ systems and their evolution with emphasis on human anatomy. Three laboratory hours a week" to read "Vertebrate comparative

anatomy of organ systems and their evolution with emphasis on human anatomy. Three laboratory hours a week.” (fall 2013)

BIOL 601 Advanced Topics and Literature in Biology. Inactivate the course.

BIOL 691H Senior Honors Thesis. Add department consent. Change the course description from “Prerequisites, permission of a faculty research director and three credit hours of BIOL 395 in the same laboratory. Students with six hours of BIOL 395 must take BIOL 692H. See also the description of honors and highest honors under Special Undergraduate Opportunities in Biology in the statement preceding course descriptions. Required of all candidates for honors or highest honors in their senior year” to read “Permission of a faculty research director and three credit hours of BIOL 395 in the same laboratory required. Students with six hours of BIOL 395 must take BIOL 692H. Required of all candidates for honors or highest honors in their senior year. See description on the department's undergraduate Web page.”

BIOL 692H Senior Honors Thesis. Add department consent. Change grading basis from Pass/Fail to graded. Change the course description from “Prerequisites, permission of a faculty research director and six credit hours of BIOL 395 in the same laboratory. Students with six hours of BIOL 395 must take BIOL 692H. See also the description of honors and highest honors under Special Undergraduate Opportunities in Biology in the statement preceding course descriptions. Required of all candidates for honors or highest honors in their senior year. This course is offered for pass/fail credit only” to “Permission of a faculty research director and six credit hours of BIOL 395 in the same laboratory. Students with six hours of BIOL 395 must take BIOL 692H. Required of all candidates for honors or highest honors in their senior year. See description on department's undergraduate Web page.”

BUSI 505 Entrepreneurial Consulting. Change the course title from “Consulting to Entrepreneurial Firms” to “Entrepreneurial Consulting.” Change the short title from CONSULTING TO ESHIP FIRMS to ENTREPRENEURIAL CONSULTING. Remove the prerequisite BUSI 500. Change the course description from “Student teams serve as business consultants to actual small businesses and other entrepreneurial ventures” to read “Student teams serve as consultants to actual startups. The course combines consulting frameworks and opportunity assessment tools, giving students a real-world learning experience working with entrepreneurs.”

DRAM 495 Stage Management. Renumber to DRAM 460.

MATH 130P Precalculus Mathematics. Approved by administrative action for zero credit hours to enable PL credit for various achievement tests.

PLCY 698 Practicum in Public Policy. Change prerequisites from “PLCY 460, and PLCY 691 or 691H” to “PLCY 460, and 681 or 691H.”
