Miscellaneous Curriculum Changes (effective fall 2013)

Department of Dramatic Art

Major in Dramatic Art

- To add DRAM 291, 292, 297, 298, and 489 to the list of courses in dramatic literature/theatre history/criticism

Minor in Dramaturgy

- To add DRAM 291, 292, 297, 298, and 489 to the list of courses fulfilling the minor

Department of Geography

Major in Geography

- To eliminate the three concentrations that currently have different requirements and require all students to take four GEOG courses, at least three of which must be at or above the 400 level or above
- To require all students to take GEOG 391 or 392
- To remove the requirement that students in the Geography of Human Activity (GHA) concentration take a regional geography course
- To eliminate GEOG 112 as a requirement for the major

Department of History

Minor in Medieval and Early Modern Studies

- To increase the number of 100-level courses allowed from two to three, and remove the restriction that they must come from different departments
- To update course list by adding, removing, and renumbering courses

Department of Linguistics

Major in Linguistics

- To allow up to two courses from outside the department, from a specific course list from allied areas of study, to count towards the major

Curriculum in Peace, War, and Defense

Major in Peace, War and Defense

- To update concentrations with new courses
- To remove courses from concentrations that have been inactivated
- To allow students to substitute a different statistics course for STOR 151, 155 or POLI 181
- To remove PWAD 692H as an option to fulfill a concentration requirement

Department of Philosophy

Minor in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics (PPE)

- To add PLCY 352H Seminar on Domestic and International Affairs to the list of courses fulfilling the political science requirement.

Department of Public Policy

Major in Public Policy

- To remove PLCY 691H as a substitute for PLCY 681; all majors will be required to complete PLCY 681

- To allow students completing PLCY 691H to receive three credit hours toward their field concentrations

Minor in Public Policy

- To add PLCY 681 to the list of core courses permitted for completion of the minor
- To reduce the number of core courses to four
- To allow the fifth course to be any PLCY course at the 100-level or above

Department of Religious Studies

Major in Religious Studies – Jewish Studies Concentration

- To add ASIA 60, HEBR 142, and RELI 211 to the list of requirements

Minor in Jewish Studies

- To add ASIA 60, 235; HEBR 142; JWST 697; RELI 211, 566 to the list of requirements

Major in Religious Studies

- To update course lists for each subfield

Minor in Religious Studies

- To clarify that courses listed in more than one subfield may be counted for only one subfield

Department of Sociology

Minor in Social and Economic Justice

- To add courses to the “Understanding Justice,” “Justice in Action,” and “Context of Justice” course lists
- To remove GEOG/WMST 225 from the “Justice in Action” course list
- To clarify that only one core course may count towards the minor
- To clarify the language describing one of the options for fulfilling the service-learning option
