# MISCELLANEOUS APPROVALS October 6, 2010

#### 1. CCO Course approvals

MUSC 143 Introduction to Rock Music, a CCO course authored and taught by Molly M. Breckling

## 2. Curriculum Changes, effective fall 2011

#### <u>Curriculum in Applied Sciences and Engineering</u>

To eliminate APPL 460 and BMME 400 as required courses for the biomedical engineering track of the BS degree with a major in applied science.

## Department of Art

To revise the BA requirement for the art history major from "Three elective courses from ART 200 to 699" to "Three elective courses from ART 200 to 699; one first-year seminar taught by an art history faculty member (ART 053, 054, 061, 064, 066, 077, 079, 080, 084, 089 [with approval based on topic]) may count as an elective."

To revise "Art history capstone: ART 697" to "Art history capstone: ART 697. Students who have successfully completed ART 691H and are enrolled in 692H are exempted from this requirement; they may substitute for the capstone course a fourth elective at the 200 to 699 level."

## **Department of Biology**

To remove BIOL 405 and add BIOL 563 and BIOL 431/PHYS 405 to the list of three biology electives for the quantitative biology track of the BS degree with a major in biology.

To revise the sentence "At least two courses in biology must be numbered above 400 (not including 501, 691H, 692H)" to read "At least two courses out of the five courses (four electives and one organismal course) must be numbered above 400 (not including 501, 691H, 692H)" in the list of requirements for the BS degree with a major in biology.

To revise the sentence "At least one course in biology must be numbered above 400 (not including 501, 691H, 692H)" to read "At least one course out of the four courses (three electives and one organismal course) must be numbered above 400 (not including 501, 691H, 692H)" in the list of requirements for the BA degree with a major in biology.

### Department of English and Comparative Literature

To revise the course list for the BA with a major in comparative literature by adding CMPL 474 to List B Literature in Translation Courses, by moving CMPL 254 from List B Literature in Translation Courses to List D Courses in Film, and by updating the course number of LGLA 203 to LGLA 403.

## **Department of Exercise and Sport Science**

To correct an error in last year's request to revise the sport administration concentration for the BA degree with a major in exercise and sport science by removing EXSS 273 as a required course and requiring six, rather than three, credit hours of EXSS courses numbered 200 or higher.

To approve the minor in coaching education as a "by approval only" minor

To add EXSS 376 to the list of courses from which students minoring in coaching education may choose two

To revise the minor in exercise and sport science to include BIOL 101/101L; one course from EXSS 188, 220, or 221; EXSS 376 or 385; and EXSS 181, 380, and 408 (students taking both EXSS 376 and 385 need only take two courses from the EXSS 181, 380, 408 group)

#### Curriculum in Peace, War, and Defense

To add HIST 276 Modern Middle East to the list of courses fulfilling the culture of peace and war concentration and the national and international defense and security concentration for the major in peace, war, and defense.

#### Department of Romance Languages

To add SPAN 348 to the list of courses satisfying major requirements for the BA degree with a major in Romance languages and an emphasis in Spanish. [SPAN 625, which the department also wanted to add, has already been approved for the major.]

#### **Curriculum in Global Studies**

To revise the course lists for the major as follows:

Add ECON 360 and 265 and WMST 281 to the list of "Two core courses, each from a different department" and delete INTS 265, 281, and 360 from the same list
