Proposed Increase in Maximum Credit Hours in a Semester

Current Language, "Academic Procedures," 2013-2014 Undergraduate Bulletin, p. 410:

Students may not enroll in more than 18 academic hours unless they have earned a 3.000 grade point average in the preceding regular semester and have a cumulative 2.500 grade point average. Exceptions require the approval of the student's dean. With approval of their dean, seniors meeting graduation requirements during their final semester in residence may enroll in <u>20 academic hours</u> if they have a cumulative and preceding semester grade point average of 2.000.

Proposed Revision:

Students may not enroll in more than 18 academic hours unless they have earned a 3.000 grade point average in the preceding regular semester and have a cumulative 2.500 grade point average. Exceptions require the approval of the student's dean. With approval of their dean, seniors meeting graduation requirements during their final semester in residence may enroll in <u>21 academic hours</u> if they have a cumulative and preceding semester grade point average of 2.000.
