

PROPOSED CHANGES FOR THE MAJOR IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES

I. Intellectual and Theoretical Foundations: 12 credits

II. Interdisciplinary Perspectives: 9 credits from at least two of the following **categories**: historical studies, basic and applied sciences, humanities and fine arts, social sciences

III. Theory and Practice of Women's Studies: 3 credits from the following

- 1. A faculty-supervised internship (WMST 391)--must be arranged in the semester PRIOR to the semester of the internship (see Internship Guidelines on the website).**
- 2. A fourth course drawn from interdisciplinary perspectives courses (II above), which can be taken in any of the four subcategories listed.**
- 3. For qualified students, a year-long honors thesis (WMST 691H)—must be arranged in the semester prior to the year of the thesis. Requires approval of the department and the instructor (see Honors Thesis Guidelines on the WMST website).**
