Minoring in Korean

The undergraduate minor in Korean consists of four courses. Three courses are language courses beyond KOR 203 (the first semester of Intermediate Korean), chosen from among: KOR 204, 305, and 306, or 407. The fourth course must be chosen from among the following courses: ARTH/ASIA 158; ASIA 253; ECON 469; JAPN 376; KOR 150, 151, 327.
