The Anthropology major requires that students take one course each in Archaeology, Biological Anthropology and Cultural Anthropology. To fill these requirements the students choose from a list of acceptable courses. We would like to add two courses to the lists of approved courses for these requirements. Specifically we would like to add:

ANTH 149 *Great Discoveries in Archaeology* (put on the books Fall 2015) to the list of approved archaeology courses

ANTH 217 *Human Biology in Comparative Perspective* (course proposal submitted, pending approval for Fall 2016) to the list of approved biological anthropology courses
