The following courses are being added to the minor:

- ANTH 361: Community in India and South Asia
- HIST/ASIA 272: Contemporary India, Pakistan, and Bangladesh [being proposed concurrently]
- HIST 331/ASIA 304: Sex, Religion, and Violence: Revolutionary Thought in Modern South Asia [ASIA crosslist being proposed concurrently]
- HIST/ASIA 555: Religion, Coexistence, and Conflict in Medieval India [being proposed concurrently]
- HIST/ASIA 556: Gender in Indian History [being proposed concurrently]
- HIST/ASIA 557: Bandits, Rebels, and Storytellers: Fiction and History in India [being proposed concurrently]

The minor description is also being changed to reflect the concurrent proposal to crosslist ASIA 164 with MUSC 164.

Finally, language has been added to the minor description to more explicitly clarify the policy on PL credit.

Hindi-Urdu Minor

The undergraduate minor in Hindi-Urdu consists of four courses. Three courses are language courses beyond HNUR 203 (the first semester of Intermediate Hindi-Urdu), chosen from among HNUR 204, 305, 306, 407, 408, 410, or 490. The other course must be chosen from among the following: <u>ANTH 361</u>; ARTH/ASIA 153, 266, 273, 456; ASIA 59, 61, 152, 163, 164, 224, 228, 231, 232, 261, 262, 331, 332, 333, 453; ASIA/HIST 135, 136, <u>272, 555, 556, 557; ASIA 304/HIST 331</u>; <u>ASIA/MUSC 164</u>; ASIA/RELI 285, 382, 383, 581, 582, 583; ASIA 300/RELI 283; HNUR 592; RELI 381. <u>Placement credit (PL) may not be used to meet minor requirements.</u>
