No actual changes are being made to the Korean minor this year. However, we have added language to the minor description that will more explicitly clarify the policy on PL credit.

Korean Minor

The undergraduate minor in Korean consists of four courses. Three courses are language courses beyond KOR 203 (the first semester of Intermediate Korean), chosen from KOR 204, 305, 306, 407. The fourth course must be chosen from among the following courses: ARTH/ASIA 158; ECON 469; JAPN 376; KOR 150, 151, 327. Placement credit (PL) may not be used to meet minor requirements.
