Curriculum Revision Request: Neuroscience Minor

Dear Administrative Boards:

We write to request that PSYC 220 (Biological Psychology), 420 (Functional Neuroanatomy), PSYC 424 (Neural Connections: Hands on Experience), and BMME 445 (Systems Neuroscience) be added to the approved list of elective courses for the Neuroscience minor. Because of similarity in content between PSYC 220 and BMME 445, students may receive elective credit for one of these courses, but not both.
