The only change to the Chinese minor this year is the addition of a crosslist to an existing minor course, ASIA/WMST 56, Writing Women in Modern China.

Chinese Minor

The undergraduate minor in Chinese consists of five courses. At least three of the courses must be language courses beyond CHIN 203 (the first semester of Intermediate Chinese), chosen from among the following: CHIN 204, 212, 305, 306, 313, 407, 408, 414, 440, 441, 442, 443, 490, 510, 511, 525, 532, 590, or 631. The other two courses may be chosen either from the same list or from among the following: ASIA 52, 55, 56, 65, 453; ASIA/WMST 56; CHIN 150, 231, 232, 242, 244, 252, 253, 255, 342, 346, 354, 356, 361, 367, 463, 464, 531, 551, 552, 562, 563. No more than one first-year seminar may be counted toward the minor.
