SIGNATURE **RE:** Program Changes

These changes to our Art History major geographic and chronological distributions complement the new major course-number distributions approved last year and

complement the new major course-number distributions approved last year and implemented this year. This new structure reflects our changing faculty makeup and a shift away from narrow concentrations toward broader knowledge and a more global definition of the field. It also streamlines the major, making it both more clear and more flexible.

Art History Major, B.A.

Core requirements

Two Art History foundation courses from ARTH 100 to 199 (6 credits)

Eight ARTH courses above 199*, apportioned in the following way (24 credits):

- a. At least one course from three of the four geographic areas: The Americas (AA); Europe and the Mediterranean (EM); Asian and the Middle East (AM); Africa (AF)
- b. At least one course from each of the following chronological areas: Prehistoric-1300 (I); 1300-1800 (II); 1800-Present (III)
- c. At least three courses must be numbered above 399

• One undergraduate research seminar, ARTH 391 (offered with three chronological topic areas). It is strongly recommended that students take this seminar no later than the spring of their junior year (3 credits).

• One studio art ARTS course (3 credits)

* A first-year seminar taught by an art history faculty member (ARTH 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 61, 64, 66, 77, 79, 80, 84, 89, 90 [with approval based on topic]) may be substituted for one art history course numbered above 199.
