Re: Request for changes to the minor in Persian

We are proposing a structural change to the Persian minor. Due to instructor workload and enrollment issues, the third-year Persian courses are now being offered alternately, one per year. In order to keep the Persian minor accessible even though the advanced Persian courses are offered less frequently, we are shifting the balance between language and culture courses required for the minor. Instead of 3 language + 1 culture, as currently required, students will have the flexibility to alternatively complete the minor with 2 language + 2 culture courses.

Attached is a revised version of the minor text for the Undergraduate Bulletin.
