#### American Studies Major, B.A. – American Indian and Indigenous Studies Concentration

1. Update the **“Law and Social Science”** course list:

2. Update the Arabic Literature and Culture Courses list:

## Asian Studies Major, B.A. – Chinese Concentration

1. For both Track A and Track B, update the upper-level language course list:
  - Add CHIN 521, Chinese History in Chinese
  - Add CHIN 624, Chinese Internet Literature
  - Remove CHIN 532 (inactivated)

## Chinese Minor

1. Update the language course list:
  - Add CHIN 521, Chinese History in Chinese
  - Add CHIN 624, Chinese Internet Literature
  - Remove CHIN 532 (inactivated)

## Conflict Management Minor

1. Revise the structure of the 5 course minor:
  - Require PSYC 101. PSYC 101 was previously a required *prerequisite* for all the courses from the “human behavior and brain function” requirement list, but did not count as 1 of the 5 courses in the minor. This would remove the challenge that non-PSYC students currently face.
  - Select *either* one course from the “human behavior and brain function” list or one course from the “domestic- and internationally-related courses” list.
2. Update the “**Practical-based**” courses (students select 3 courses)
  - Add PHIL 105, How to Reason and Argue
  - Add PHIL 164, Morality and Business
  - Limit students to only 1 Philosophy (PHIL) course
3. Update the “**Domestic- and Internationally-Related**” course list
  - Add PLCY 430, Analysis of National Security Policy
  - Add POLI 235, The Politics of Russia and Eurasia

## Food Studies Minor

1. Update the elective course list:
  - Add AMST 220, On the Question of the Animal: Contemporary Animal Studies
  - Add EXSS 360, Sports Nutrition

## Middle Eastern Languages Minor

1. Update the Turkish course list:
  - Add TURK 305, Advanced Turkish (pending Course Committee approval)

## Modern Hebrew Minor

1. Update the elective course list:
  - Add ASIA 358, Religion and Tradition in Israeli Cinema, TV, and Literature

## Psychology Major, B.S.

1. Students are required to take at least four additional non-psychology physical and life sciences courses (from a specific list), including one with laboratory and one **physical science course**. Remove the additional condition/requirement that 1 of the 4 must be a physical science course.

This is a hold-over from when the Gen Ed curriculum (prior to 2006) differentiated physical science and life science courses.
