### English and Comparative Literature Major, B.A. – Film Studies Concentration

1. **Reduce the Film elective requirement from 5 courses to 3 courses. Add an additional requirement of any 2 ENGL and/or CMPL courses** (excluding first-year seminars, ENGL 100, 105/I, 110, and 190). This does not change the total number of courses/hours for the concentration. It provides more flexibility, particularly to students who change concentrations within the major.

1. In the “**Ecology and Society Concentration**”, reference **ENEC 272** in the cross-list with BIOL 272, Local Flora.

### Environmental Sciences Major, B.S.

1. Update the “**GIS and Remote Sensing**” course list:
  - **Remove GEOG 391**, Quantitative Methods in Geography
  - **Add GEOG 491**, Introduction to GIS
  - **Add ENEC 479**, Landscape Analysis
2. In the “**Ecology and Natural Resources Concentration**”, reference **ENEC 272** in the cross-list with BIOL 272, Local Flora.

## Environmental Sciences Major, B.S. – Quantitative Energy Systems Track

1. Update the **“GIS and Remote Sensing”** course list:
  - **Remove GEOG 391**, Quantitative Methods in Geography
  - **Add ENEC 479**, Landscape Analysis
2. Update the **“Infomatics”** Skills course list:
  - **Remove INLS 151**, Retrieving and Analyzing Information
  - **Add INLS 201**, Foundations of Information Science
  - **Add INLS 382**, Information Systems Analysis and Design
  - **Add INLS 523**, Introduction to Database Concepts and Applications
3. Update the **“Energy and Management”** concentration course list:
  - **Add ENEC 407**, Principles of Energy Conversion
  - **Add ENEC 432**, Environmental Life Cycle Assessment

## Geography Major, B.A.

- Reduce the number of “400-level or above” GEOG courses in the electives requirement from three (3) courses to two (2) courses. This will provide more flexibility for students interested in the 200- and 300-level courses.

## Sustainability Studies Minor

1. Add **ENEC 204** (Environmental Seminar) to the seminar/practicum core requirement (1 hour). The revised requirement will read ENEC 210 or ENEC 204 or ENEC 593.
2. Add the following courses to the elective list:
  - **ENEC 407**, Principles of Energy Conversion
  - **ENEC 432**, Environmental Life Cycle Assessment
  - **ENEC 698**, Policy Instruments for Environmental Management
  - **ENEC/PLAN 420**, Community Design and Green Architecture
  - **Catalog note:** re-ordered the list by ENEC numeric order, not by cross-list alpha order. This should make it easier to find courses.
